

Privacy Button

Operation Guide

The Privacy Button allows the operative to quickly enable or disable privacy mode when required.

When the switch is used to activate privacy mode, the cameras will begin to power down and may take up to 45 seconds to stop recording. When privacy mode is switched off, the cameras may take up to 20 seconds to power back up and resume recording.

The switch light will be on when the cameras are recording and off when privacy mode is active. The dashcam also has a blue recording light to show whether the camera is recording.

If you experience any issues with the Privacy Button or camera system, please report them to your supervisor immediately.



The Privacy Button is mounted on the driver's side of the dashboard, adjacent to the air vent.

- Only use privacy mode when required by your operating procedure or site rules
- Before starting work, make sure you understand when privacy mode should and should not be used
- The Privacy Button switch is fitted in the cab, beside the dashboard area shown in the image
- To activate privacy mode, flick the switch
- After activating privacy mode, allow up to 45 seconds for the cameras to power down and stop recording
- When privacy mode is active, the switch light will be off
- To return the cameras to recording mode, flick the switch back
- After privacy mode is switched off, allow up to 20 seconds for the cameras to power back up and begin recording
- When the camera system is recording, the switch light will be on
- Always check the blue light on the dashcam to confirm whether the camera is recording
- Never assume privacy mode is active immediately after using the switch without allowing for the power-down delay
- Never assume the cameras are recording again immediately after switching privacy mode off without allowing for the power-up delay
- Never leave the vehicle or equipment in the wrong mode for the task being carried out
- Do not operate the Privacy Button unless you have received operational training
- If the switch or indicator lights do not operate as expected, report the fault immediately
